



A system supporting electronic education

The e-Amos Project, <http://www.eAmos.cz>, is a web publication system consisting of a number of modules each with its own function. Users enter the system through an Internet browser without having to instal any special software.

The aim of the project is to provide a basis for the creation, distribution, and management of electronic educational courses for those users who are not experts in the creation of applications on the Internet. The e-Amos Project makes it possible for a large number of teachers to create and control electronic courses. Generally, the system sets out to automate the maximum amount of work connected with educational administration at all levels, and in this way to facilitate the work and minimize the

potential mistakes of users (both students and teachers). Materials processed in this way are very suitable for all kinds of studies – distance, regular, and combinations of both. Their importance is especially obvious where materials need frequent updating.

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
